**Halacha Corner:** 1. On Friday night, Chanukah candles can be lit any time from 4:01 until 4:41 The candles or oil should be sufficient to burn until 6:10 PM. (If time is pressured, you can defer the singing of Maoz Tzur until the meal on Friday night.) 2. Chanukah candles are lit before Shabbos candles. 3. On motzei Shabbat, some light Chanukah candles before Havdalah, and some make havdalah first. Both practices are acceptable.
